2024 YEAR 10 STUDENT RESOURCE SCHEME

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THE PURPOSE OF THE STUDENT RESOURCE SCHEME (SRS)

Dear Parent / Carer,

This document includes important information about the fees and inclusions for the SRS. Once you opt into the SRS at the College, your participation is assumed for the remainder of your child's enrolment, unless you inform the College otherwise by completing a new Participation Agreement Form (PAF). If you are a new parent to the College, this information will assist you in making a decision as to whether you wish to participate in the SRS.

WHAT IS PROVIDED BY THE QUEENSLAND GOVERNMENT?

The Queensland Government supports children's education by providing funding for instruction (teachers), facilities (College grounds and buildings, internet), and administration (staff to run the College). Funding for the College does not extend to individual student resources such as textbooks, equipment for personal use, and many items used by the student in the classroom.

The SRS helps parents to source these resources. The College can purchase resources at lower rates due to its bulk buying power. Resources such as textbooks or musical instruments that will be used over a period are hired to students to further reduce costs for families. Participating in the SRS also offers a convenient way for parents to source the items that their child needs for school and ensures that all students have access to the same standard of resources.

Owned	 These items are retained by the student and used as required (e.g., student ID Card)
Hired	 These items are hired to the student for use for a specific period of time (e.g., textbooks or class room used musical instruments) Hired items MUST be returned to the College in a reasonable condition at the end of the hire period or if the student leaves the College. A repair or replacement cost may be charged to the parent if any hired items are damaged or not returned.
Used	 These items are used / consumed in class by the student (e.g., Industrial Technology / cooking / art supplies) Work/items produced from these resources will remain the property of the student.

THE FEE

Items provided by the scheme vary from owned, hired or used in class. Some examples are ID cards, textbooks or specialised equipment, stationary items, workbooks, etc. A list of items by subject/year level is available on our website.

If you are not satisfied that the SRS fee represents good value for money based on the inclusions (over the page), you may choose not to participate in the SRS. If that is the case, please complete a new Participation Agreement Form, indicating that you no longer wish to participate. If you choose not to participate, you will be provided with a detailed list of resources that you will need to provide for the student.

THE TEXTBOOK AND RESOURCE ALLOWANCE (TRA)

STATE SECONDARY COLLEGE

The Department of Education provides a Textbook and Resource Allowance (TRA) to assist parents with the cost of textbooks and other education resources for eligible Years 7 to 12 students.

For those students who are eligible to receive the TRA, the TRA will be applied to reduce the cost of participation as shown in the table below. Thus, the SRS invoice you receive will be the full cost of participation in the SRS minus the TRA already held at the College. Information on the TRA can be found on the department's website <u>Textbook and resource allowance (education.gld.gov.au)</u>

Please be aware that there may be two lines of charges on your invoice indicating the GST inclusive and GST exclusive fees depending on the resources supplied by the SRS.

COST BREAKDOWN

The diagram below reflects how the TRA has been deducted from the SRS fee for eligible students who have opted in to the Core SRS.

If you have opted to pay for the SRS you will be invoiced for the full amount of \$260. The following payment options are available -

- A single payment for the full year's fees
 - Term instalments paid over the first 3 terms
 - o \$100 Term 1
 - o \$80 in Term 2
 - \$80 in Term 3 (see key payment dates on page 7)
- An instalment plan as negotiated with the College (e.g., direct debit, Centrepay or BPoint)



FINANCIAL DIFFICULTY

If you would like to participate, but are experiencing financial difficulties, please contact the College to arrange an appointment to discuss options. Any information that you provide will be confidential.

RELEASE OF RESOURCES

Resources will not be distributed until full fees are paid, or first instalment is paid, or a payment plan has been established. Any unpaid invoices will be managed according to the Department's Debt Management Procedure and may result in the student being excluded from the scheme and/or from participating in extracurricular activities until payments are made.

RETURN OF HIRED RESOURCES

A repair or replacement cost will be charged to the parent for any items that are damaged or not returned.

STUDENT RESOURCE SCHEME - PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT FORM

If you wish to participate in the SRS, you are required to complete, sign and return a Student Resource Scheme – Participation Agreement Form. If your child is a current student at MHSSC and you have previously opted into the SRS, your participation is assumed for the remainder of your child's enrolment unless you inform the College otherwise by completing a new Student Resource Scheme - Participation Agreement Form.

Points for your attention- (Refer to page 2 of Student Resource Scheme – Participation Agreement Form)

- **15.** Parents who choose **not** to participate in the SRS are responsible for providing their student with all items that would otherwise be provided to the student by the SRS to enable their student to engage with the curriculum.
- **18.** As the SRS operates for the benefit of participating parents and is funded from participation fees, SRS resources will not be issued to students whose parents choose not to participate in the SRS.

NON-SRS PARTICIPATING STUDENTS

If you opt not to participate in the Student Resource Scheme, students in Year 7 to 12 will be required to provide all textbooks and other resources required for the subject that are in addition to College provided resources. Lists are provided below.

An additional invoice will be created for non-participating students when teacher created resources are provided instead of textbooks or other resources in a particular subject.
