Potential Future Scholars need to be REAL Learners who are:


- Problem solvers and 'out of the box' creative thinkers

Entrance into Future Scholars is a two-stage process

All students applying for entry must submit an Expression of Interest and digital entry project. The results from academic and NAPLAN results, and applicant endorsement will be considered when shortlisting students for the Inquiry Immersion Day. Final selection for Future Scholars class 2024 will occur following participation in the Inquiry Immersion Day which is inclusive of academic and problem solving testing.

Stage 1: Expression of Interest

- 1. Submit your 2024 Enrolment Package and attend a group enrolment session (Begin your enrolment process by completing an Enrolment Enquiry)
- 2. Complete and return an Expression of Interest with supporting documentation
- 3. Produce and submit a digital entry project online or via USB to the College
- 4. All steps for Stage 1 need to be completed on or before Friday 15 September, 2023

Stage 2: Inquiry Immersion Day

- 1. Successful applicants are shortlisted based on supporting documentation and entry project
- 2. Shortlisted students are invited to attend the Immersion Inquiry and Testing Day
- 3. Students attend Immersion Inquiry Day on Friday 13 October 2023
- 4. Successful applicants notified of entry into 2024 Future Scholars by 3 November 2023
- 5. Acceptance of placement in 2024 Future Scholars due to the College by Wednesday 10 November 2023
